



## FILM FINDER - HOW IT WORKS

- On entering Film Finder all filters are unselected and the data sheet list area will have every data sheet in its multi-page list.
- Filters can be applied in the following areas:-
  - a. Market
  - b. Application
  - c. Language
  - d. Attribute
- Filters apply top-down, selecting higher level filters determines the options available in the lower level filters.
- You can start filtering at any level e.g. if you want all English data sheets then select the Language filter group and then highlight the English filter.
- Filter areas can be skipped e.g. you can select Biodegradable/Sustainable in the Market filter group and then move directly to English in the Language group.
- For the first 3 filter groups (Market, Application and Language) you can only select one valid entry at a time. The selected filter is highlighted and displayed in the breadcrumb. The filter can be unselected by clicking on it a second time or by selecting another filter in the same filter group.
- The Attribute filter group allows multiple selections and these can be unselected by clicking on any selected filter a second time.
- The list of data sheets always reflects the current filter selections.
- A brief description of each datasheet can be viewed by clicking on the [+] before the PDF icon on each line in the data sheet list.
- The 'Reset product filters' clears all current filter selections but will not remove any items currently in the DocBox.

- Add all to DocBox will add all the datasheets that match the current filter criteria to the DocBox (shopping basket for data sheets) which is the first step to downloading your selection.
- The Download button listed against each data sheet allows for immediate download of a single data sheet.
- Once you have all the datasheets you require in the DocBox, click on the DocBox icon and then Proceed to Download. At this point you can remove datasheets from your download by selecting the tick box for the unwanted data sheet(s) and Apply Selections to remove. Similarly you can bookmark datasheets so you will be notified if they are updated but you must be a registered user and logged in to use this functionality. Click on Proceed to Download once you are happy with your selections. This prepares the datasheets for download by creating a ZIP file. Then click on the Download button to start the download. You can then select to open the ZIP file directly or save to disc/folder and open later.
- The DocBox also works in the Document Downloads area of the site.
